WHAT ELSE IS NEW AT ICON EYE CARE?

ICON Eye Care is now participating in three clinical research trials!

- 1. Perfluorohexyloctane- Dry eye study sponsored by Bausch and Lomb that uses an eye drop to treat dry eye disease associated with MGD.
- Beacon Aqueous Microshunt- Glaucoma study sponsored by MicroOPTX that uses a glaucoma device to treat advanced glaucoma.
- 3. iDose- Glaucoma study sponsored by Glaukos that uses a glaucoma device to treat ocular hypertension and mild to moderate open-angle glaucoma.
